Artist description:

Born in London in 1983, Alice von Maltzahn is a contemporary artist living and working in London. She studied art at Wimbledon College of Fine Art and The Ruskin School of Drawing and Fine Art at Oxford University. Between 2011 and 2013 Alice von Maltzahn worked with Wendt + Friedman Gallery in Berlin, on both group and solo exhibitions in Berlin and Cologne. In 2014 she was featured in the title Paper Play; follow up to the bestselling Paper Works published by Sandu Press, an exploration of international artists working in the medium of paper.

“Through paper, ink, graphite and gold, von Maltzahn constructs pathways between structures that are built - that require further building if they are to grow - and those that will forge their own way. With no human impact, nature will win.”
